The Drug & Alcohol Health Services Library is a state wide service funded by the NSW Health Mental Health and Drug and Alcohol Office (MHDAO).

WHAT WE HAVE

The Library collection consists of:

The collection's emphasis is on the psycho-social aspects of drug and alcohol use. Australian material is comprehensively collected.
